



Homework Timetable

Year 10

Homework and Independent Study are vital to exam success. In some subjects, extended pieces of work should be done over a period of time. This should be noted in the planner and some time set aside for completion leading up to the deadline.

The timetable sets out guidelines for when homework should be set. Depending on the particular time of year or focus on the scheme of work this may alter.

However, as a guide:

- Core Subjects – English, Maths and Science – 2 Homework tasks per week.
- Option Subjects – 2 homework subjects per week.

Some option subjects are practical or coursework based and so may set extended tasks which should be done over a period of time.

At certain times of the year (examination periods or coursework deadline dates) homework may not be set but revision or coursework completion will take its place.
