Ex-Student to captain England Under 20s

Ex-Richmond School Student, Calum Clark, has been named captain of England's Under 20 side.

The Leeds Carnegie flanker will take the team into the RBS Under 20 Six Nations tournament which kicks off on Friday 6th February. The first match is against Italy at Worcester.

Calum became the youngest forward to appear in the Guinness Premiership at his first match for Leeds in 2007. He has represented England at Under 16, 18 and 20 levels.

Calum's dad, Dave Clark, who is also the Deputy Head at Richmond

School said "We are delighted for Calum, he has worked very hard at his rugby and this is a fantastic honour for him. Calum captained his school team at Richmond School but being chosen to captain England was a big surprise. We wish him all the very best in the Six Nations campaign and in the World Cup in Japan in June."
