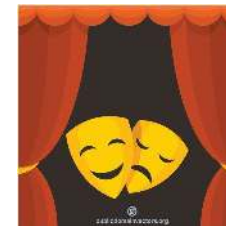




Year 8 Creativity Challenge!

Once all of your entries are in, we will be selecting FIVE winners who will receive prizes and have their work shared and celebrated!

You could present your work in any form you wish. Here are some ideas to get you thinking...

- Dance Performance
- Compose/ perform a piece of Music
- Devise a Drama performance
- Write/ Sing a song
- Create/ perform a rap
- Create a piece of artwork (painting/ sculpture etc.)
- Creative writing/ poetry
- Textiles/ sewing
- Cooking/ baking
- Create a video (you may even choose to work with your friends to film and edit clips together)

...The possibilities are endless!

Remember, the coronavirus is just the stimulus (starting point) for your ideas - we want to see you being as creative as possible with this too!

Some ideas to base your work on could be...

- The virus itself (origins/ speed of spread/ how it impacts the body)
- Lockdown - global efforts/ politics/ rules & regulations
- Social distancing - isolation/ being away from loved ones
- 'Stay at Home' - impacts of this (positive & negative)
- Rainbows - coming together/ community
- NHS staff/ key workers - bravery/ selflessness/ appreciation.
- Impact/ aftermath - changes to environment/ economy/ society as a whole.
