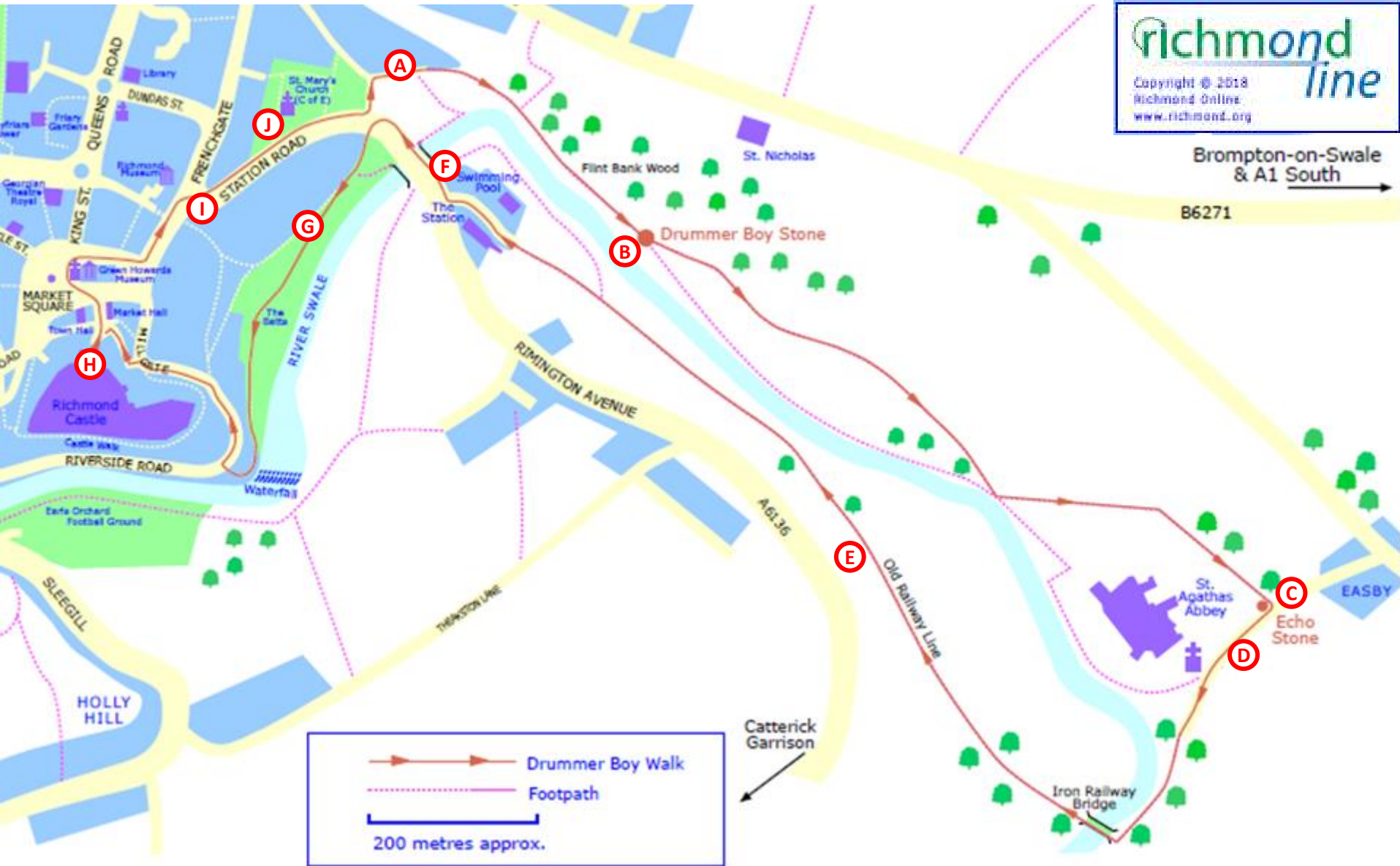


THE DRUMMER BOY TRAIL

You can begin this circular trail from any point – the questions should make sense no matter where you start or whether you go clockwise or anticlockwise round this loop. It is approximately 5K/3miles in distance.

(E)	If you turned off the old railway line here, crossed the cattle grid and followed the cycle track how far is it to Catterick Garrison?	
(F)	What two names has this bridge been known by?	
(G)	According to the 'Town Trail' sign, 'The Batts' originates from Scandinavian and means...	
(H)	According to the sign at the entrance, Richmond Castle is the of the Dales.	
(I)	Which former Richmond School teacher (or master) once lived in Swale House?	
(J)	What happens at St Mary's Church every second Sunday at 6:30pm?
